Dear Parents,

RE: 2019 Secondary Booklists are now live

In 2019, the College will continue using an online booklist service provided by Officemax to service secondary students. For your convenience, you can purchase all stationery and textbooks required through the Officemax online service. Some listed items can be sourced elsewhere if preferred; however, we recommend all eBooks are purchased through this service to ensure ease of access using the OMX eBooks app.

Here are some points to help outline this process:

1. How to access booklists

- a. Visit www.mcc.vic.edu.au and select 'Booklist' under the Quick Links section.
- b. Select the relevant year level's booklist you require.
- c. Follow the instructions on the front page of the booklist to access it online.
- d. The required access code is printed on the booklist front page.

2. When to purchase books

- a. Please take note of delivery cut-off dates on the front page of the booklist to ensure all texts are purchased in time for term 1 2019.
- b. Free delivery ends on the **2nd December 2018**.
- c. *Orders placed **after 31st December** may not arrive prior to the start of term 1.*
- d. It is highly recommended VCE students have their books over the Christmas break to complete holiday homework.

3. Years 7-10

- a. Most of the Year 7-10 texts are eBooks that will be accessed on student iPads.
- b. Workbooks and novels are generally supplied in print.
- c. Some textbooks are only available to purchase in print, not as eBooks.
- d. Year 10 students studying a Year 11 subject are required to use the Year 11 booklist in addition to the Year 10 booklist to access the required texts for that subject.

4. VCE

- a. Students can choose between using texts in print or eBook format.
- b. Some subjects only have a print option available; however, digital versions can sometimes be purchased directly from the publisher. Specific details are provided on the booklist.

5. Delivery of books

- a. Print books and stationery items will be delivered to your home address by Officemax.
- b. Digital books: Officemax will send OMX eBooks login details and instructions directly to the student email address you enter during the ordering process.
- c. Students should use their MCC email address when prompted during the ordering process ('username@mcc.vic.edu.au'). If you are unsure of your email address, please contact the College. Alternatively, you can leave this field blank and complete the ordering process. Officemax will then contact the College for details required to complete the order.
- d. Students are encouraged to log in to the OMX eBooks app prior to the start of term 1 to ensure they have access to the required texts. Students will be supported by teachers if they are unsure how to access particular resources.
- e. eBooks are generally not refundable, so ensure you purchase for the correct subjects.

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6. Stationery items

- a. A list of recommended stationery is provided as part of the 2019 booklist.
- b. Some subjects list required stationery items that are needed specifically for that subject.
- c. Each item has a default quantity; you can adjust these as required prior to finalising your order.
- d. Do not over-order as some items can be retained from previous years; students can bring their own headphones if preferred.

7. Online courses & additional charges

In 2019 we will continue incorporating some online courses to complement the textbooks used in class. These courses help to ensure students are provided with up-to-date, relevant content. These courses were not able to be included on the booklist, rather they will be automatically charged to your account in 2019 if your child takes those subjects. See below...
